In your teams:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review each of your rose, thorn, bud post it notes together and describe the content as you go • Make sure each note is understood - edit for clarity if needed • If a team member has a post it note which are linked or similar in some way start to build clusters on your flip chart organised around different icons (for example, the ‘fish’ or the ‘star’ group) <p>Top tips!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a cluster has more than 5 or 6 post-it notes it’s probably time to divide it.
